Category	Criteria	Points
1. X-Ray Shadowing Hours	A minimum of 3 shadowing hours is required for admission. 1 point for every additional hour beyond the minimum requirement. Shadowing a total of 13 hours (or more) will earn the maximum of 10 points.	10
2. Number of Facilities Shadowed	1 point per facility, up to 5 facilities. A minimum of 1 hour per facility is required for the facility to count.	5
Subtotal for Sections 1–2	Total points for shadowing hours and number of facilities.	15
3. Medical Employment/Volunteer Experience	1 point per year of direct medical/patient care experience, up to 5 years. Examples include: CNA, MA, EMT/AEMT, LPN, RN/BSN, phlebotomist, pharmacy technician, paramedic, surgical tech, limited X-ray tech, ophthalmic tech, anesthesia tech, dental assistant/hygienist, physical therapy assistant, respiratory therapist, orderly, patient coordinator, patient transporter, radiology clerk, imaging scheduler, patient-facing hospital, clinic or hospice volunteer, etc.	5
4. Medical Education or Research Experience	(1) Healthcare Program: 5 points for completion of one of the following healthcare educational programs: CNA, MA, EMT/AEMT, LPN, RN/BSN, phlebotomy, pharmacy technician, paramedic, surgical technology, limited X-ray tech, ophthalmic tech, anesthesia tech, dental assistant/hygienist, physical therapy assistant, respiratory therapist, veterinary tech, etc. (2) Health-Related Courses: 1 point (maximum of 5) for every completed college course related to health or healthcare education. This includes health psychology, medical terminology, health law, healthcare ethics, health sciences, nutrition/dietetics, intro to health professions, public health, radiology, microbiology, patient care, etc. *Prerequisite anatomy/physiology and BLS/First Aid courses do not count. Courses must be taken at a regionally accredited, degree-granting institution. (3) Research Experience: 5 points for a scientific research experience lasting longer than 2 months. This may include bench or clinical research, data analysis, capstone projects, conference presentations (poster/oral), or journal publications.	5
5. Admissions Information Session	Attendance at an official admissions information session. A small number of admissions information sessions will be held each year.	5

6. Re-applicant Status	Re-applicants will submit a short supplemental essay describing how they have refined their goals of becoming a Radiologic Technologist and what motivates them to reapply to MTECH's Radiography Technology Program.	5

7. Essays and Writing Quality	Applicants must complete three short-answer essays. Strong essays are professionally written, free of grammatical errors, well-structured, and clearly address all aspects of the prompt. Applicants should draw on their experiences to demonstrate passion, motivation, and an understanding of Radiography. Each essay will be scored on a scale of 1-5. *A low score in this section will likely result in rejection of the application.	15
8. Application Professionalism	A holistic review of application completion, neatness, organization, attention to detail, and appropriate communication. Resumes, shadowing forms, transcripts, responses, and overall application should be professional, well-organized, and free from errors or discrepancies. This section will be scored on a scale of 1-10. *A low score in this section will likely result in rejection of the application.	10

9. Interviews	Communication skills, professionalism, program fit, passion for Radiography, maturity, empathy, critical thinking, use of personal examples, etc. *A low score in this section will likely result in rejection of the application.	40
