Learn & Work in Utah Scholarship Classes

The Automotive Technology curriculum follows the guidelines established by the National Automotive Technician Education Foundation (NATEF) and the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) now called the ASE Education Foundation. The curriculum follows the safety requirements, areas of focus, time frames and recognized task list designed by the above two agencies. This is our Base Curriculum. In addition, we also offer web-based training for Ford, Subaru, and FCA (Fiat/Chrysler America) which is integrated into our courses. This gives students the option to jumpstart their careers into any dealership service center across the nation for these companies, or work for any independently owned repair facility.

The Learn & Work Automotive Technology Program includes the following programs:

A3 Manual Drive and Axles

A4 Suspension and Steering

Certificates and Licensures

- MTECH Program Certificate for Engine Repair, Manual Drive and Axles, Suspension & Steering and Brakes.
- ASE Certifications for each program above, including Maintenance & Light Repair (MLR)
- Additional certifications are available to students wishing to continue on beyond the classes offered for the scholarship.

Program Snapshot

Registration Eligibility: Registration in the Learn & Work Scholarship Program is limited to adults only.

Registration Availability: Registration is now open. Classes begin on October 1, 2020. Enroll online on the [MTECH Student Portal](#). Registration remains open until classes are full, up until the day class starts. It is recommended to create your MTECH Student Portal account in advance.

Program Length: 810 Hours. Students must complete by June 30, 2021.

Times: Mornings, Afternoons or Evenings. Classes last five hours a day, Monday-Friday.

Locations: MTECH Lehi Trades and Technology Building, 2301 West Ashton Blvd., Lehi, UT

Financial Aid: This program is offered with a scholarship opportunity for adult students who are U.S. Citizens, or authorized aliens. Eligible students will attend the program at no charge. Tuition, Fees, Supplies and Books are covered by the Learn & Work in Utah Scholarship.

Prerequisites

Entrance Assessment: Students must take the MTECH Entrance Assessment. The Entrance Assessment is free and takes about an hour to complete. Students may use ACT tests or transcripts to waive pre-requisites, if eligible. To learn more visit mtec.edu/testing.
