

MTECH programs require meeting Math and English skill level requirements prior to registration. The requirements listed reflect skill levels needed to be successful in each program.

Program admission requirements may be met by taking MTECH's entrance exam in the Testing Center **OR** by bringing a copy of external testing or alternative documentation to the testing center for approval. Counselors, Student Services, and Testing Proctors can help determine if the external testing or alternative documentation meets the specific program admission requirements.

Prospective students with an Associate's degree or higher, do not need to satisfy any other entrance exam requirements other than a program application, where necessary. If applicable, please bring proof of degree to any MTECH Testing Center.

- Entrance Exam: Level 5-7 (3 attempts max)
- High school transcript with an average B grade or higher in completed 10th grade English course
- College transcript with an average B grade or higher in English 1010
- ACT English or Reading 21+
- Accuplacer 70+

B

- Entrance Exam: Level 4
- High school transcript with an average C grade or higher in completed 10th grade English course
- College transcript with an average C grade or higher in English 950
- ACT English or Reading 19+
- Accuplacer 65+

Math Requirements

1

- Entrance Exam: Level 5-7 (3 attempts max)
- High school transcript with an average B grade or higher in completed Secondary Math II course
- College transcript with an average B grade or higher in Math 1010
- ACT Math 22+
- Accuplacer 70+

2

- Entrance Exam: Level 4
- High school transcript with an average C grade or higher in completed Secondary Math II course
- College transcript with an average C grade or higher in Math 950
- ACT Math 19+
- Accuplacer 65+

** High school transcripts and ACT/Accuplacer scores need to be within 5 years**
